

Can you tell us more, explaining what's that, about the "private room she had created in order to turn people against me"?

There was a private room created on discord by her. The people that were invited to that room were people that had ever expressed a complaint. For example, when I versus day was only on our server. The nap would vote on the rules of that day. And of course, some people were unhappy with that vote. Like they wanted an all out battle, but the Nat had voted to only attack your opponent. So what you had an essence was a bunch of people that maybe had simple complaints that could've been discussed all in a room together feeding off of each other. Now much later, I did ask her about this room. She claimed it was only so people would discuss their complaints in there and not in alliance chat. The biggest issue with her explanation is, if I am not told about these issues, I can never resolve them therefore, how can the room be of any benefit to the alliance? So now we have a room of people complaining to each other and feeding off each other's anger. And no one addressing or trying to resolve any of it.

If that room was for letting people express complaints, then how or why it's used to turn against you?

Because the room was kept a complete secret for me. As an R5, if my people have issues, I need to know so I can address them or at least explain the situation to them. When people are unhappy with something a lot of times, you can resolve it with a simple conversation. Because this room was kept a secret from me. I was never able to talk to these people. Didn't know they had complaints. So now you got a room of say 10 people complaining about decisions that I've made or decisions the server has made. Now they're all talking to each other and feeding off of each other's anger. Which makes me the bad guy. Then Spicy Jo lead that conversation too. We should leave. And they did leave, just not all the people they thought was going to go with them went. I don't remember the exact number, but it was about 5 to 7 people that left. The reason why only that many left was because of the screenshots I received. I didn't have the entire conversation of what happened there, but I had enough bits and pieces to be able to address one or two of the complaints that people had without letting on that I knew about the room.

Has Jo ever disagreed with your plan, gone against you and you know or refuted something of yours?

Are you asking? Has she ever lead my decisions?

Yes

That would be a lot to go back through. I talked to her about everything. Yes there were many plans that helped me rework. She proofread all my presidential announcement. She reviewed every battle plan. She was in the nap. I would have to analyze everything that was said and done. The only thing that stands out in my mind right now, where there were some conversations in a nap where I felt uneasy about the way she was leading the conversation. But I completely trusted her. She basically handled the nap while I slept. That's how much trust I had in her.

They had worked so hard to get into the nap on their own and I would not take that from them. So we stood BROO back up. Brought a lot of old members back to the alliance. And the Indonesian from RLHN and from other alliances came there too. That put us back into the top 10. The nap refused to let us back in, even though we had earned our position.
